A: You may have misunderstood the term "for Workgroups." In order to install MS-DOS 6.22, you will need a floppy disk. A diskette. One that's been formatted in the MS-DOS 6.22 (as opposed to the MS-DOS 6.22 that was on the original Apple II). The typical way to go about this is to get one of those old MS-DOS 6.22 floppies. Download an ISO file for a different flavor of MS-DOS, like a version that's compatible with your PC. Then use a tool like DiskInternals Virtual Floppy Disk Driver to create a virtual floppy disk. Burn that disk to a real floppy. Then install MS-DOS on your PC. As an alternative, you can get a genuine old floppy like this: Alternatively, you can get any of the free VirtualBox images. These are built using a virtual floppy drive. You may have seen them before. By the electrochemical intercalation of transition metals, the

valence state of the intercalated transition metal atoms can be changed. In this study, we found that transition metal ions, including Cr, Mn, Fe, Co, Ni, Cu, and Zn, were successfully intercalated into 2D BP layers with different valences. The intercalated transition metals at the BP layer interface can be easily detected by scanning electron microscopy and electron energy loss spectroscopy, whereas the localized density of states shows the energy
