Specificity of in vitro responses of renal tubular cells to retinoids. We have previously shown that the synthetic retinoid retinoic acid (RA) specifically stimulates the production of glutathione (GSH) and lactate dehydrogenase (LDH) by renal tubular cells. We now demonstrate that such effects are specific and rapid. RA is inactive in the culture medium, and its uptake into the cells is much less than that of retinol (ROL). ROL is active in the culture medium, and its uptake into the cells is greater than that of RA, so that ROL is the preferred ligand. RA pretreatment of renal tubular cells for 1 h does not affect its own uptake, whereas pretreatment with ROL greatly increases uptake of both ROL and RA. Effects of RA on GSH and LDH production are specific and not due to effects of RA on cell viability. Effects of ROL on cellular uptake and the metabolism of ROL are not specific. Thus, we have defined the specificity of the stimulatory effects of RA on renal tubular cells. In addition, we have defined the mechanism of stimulation of renal tubular cells by ROL.
