[Effect of early switching of anti-HIV therapy regimens on virological suppression and side-effects in patients with HIV-1 infection]. To evaluate the efficacy and safety of early therapy switch to other anti-HIV drugs in patients with virological failure under a maintenance regimen using a drug resistance testing-based regimen. Eight patients with virological failure on an initial regimen consisting of two nucleoside reverse-transcriptase inhibitors (NRTI) and one protease inhibitor (PI) were switched to a drug resistance testing-based regimen consisting of NRTI plus a ritonavirboosted PI or an NNRTI. The patients were followed for at least 6 months after the switching. Virological failure was defined as failure to achieve an HIV-RNA level below 400 copies/mL for two consecutive measurements 2 weeks apart, or if the HIV-RNA level exceeded 400 copies/mL for at least 3 consecutive measurements, or if a rebound of HIV-RNA level > 500 copies/mL occurred. Rapid virological response (RVR) was defined as an HIV-RNA level below 50 copies/mL after 3 weeks of treatment. The patients were treated with a drug resistance testing-based regimen for at least 6 months after the switching. The mean baseline HIV-RNA level was 125 903 copies/mL (range, 10 002-605 046 copies/mL). The mean HIV-RNA level was reduced to 92 785 copies/mL at week 12 and 50 449 copies/mL at week 24 after the switching. The RVR rates were 75%, 75% and 50% at weeks 4, 12 and 24 respectively. The mean CD4+ T cell count was increased significantly from 506 cells/microL to 719 cells/microL after 24 weeks of treatment. CD4+ T cells decreased significantly to 706 cells/microL after the maintenance regimen switch. PI-induced gastrointestinal and musculoskeletal toxicities were observed in all patients, and PI-induced hyperbilirubinemia was observed in two patients. Raltegravir was administered to two patients. Switching to a drug resistance testing-based regimen did not improve the response in patients who had virological failure under a fixed-dose NRTI-containing regimen. Early switching may be considered when the patient experiences significant adverse reactions or when the HIV genotype changes. What to do
