5 Crowdfunding Platforms In Slovenia

1. WhyDonate



One of Europe's leading platforms for fundraising is [WhyDonate](#). It allows individuals and organisations to start raising money through its website. Its easy-to-use platform and reliable features make it an ideal choice for people who are looking to start a fundraising campaign.

Founded in 2012, the Netherlands-based company WhyDonate is focused on personal crowdfunding. People can easily fund various projects, such as healthcare-related initiatives, thanks to WhyDonate. It is also a great way for individuals to manage their own campaigns, as well as create multiple fundraising efforts. Moreover, the platform has active fundraising groups that allow people to make donations.

Features –

- WhyDonate charges 0% platform costs and no additional subscription costs.
- WhyDonate fees are very nominal – 1.9% + €0.25 per donation
- WhyDonate makes sure your donations and data are secure. The data is stored encrypted, and all payments are secured by licensed payment institutions.

- All international payment methods are available at WhyDonate.
- Quick payouts, options for recurring donations
- The pages are optimised to provide an optimum look on all devices, such as desktops, tablets or mobile.
- Offers [peer-to-peer fundraising](#) options.
- WhyDonate allows you to add your own custom branding and content to fundraisers, donation forms and emails.
- There are great customer support officials waiting for you to pop a question so they can assist you.
- Access WhyDonate's donor database of 350,000 donors.

2. GoFundMe



One of the most popular platforms for people to raise money for their needs is the crowdfunding website, [GoFundMe](#). It is very easy to set up an account and manage your fundraiser through GoFundMe Slovenia. Besides medical emergencies, the site also allows people to raise funds for non-profit organisations and charitable works.

Features –

- GoFundMe charges a 0% platform fee.
- Go FundMe have transaction charges that are 2.9% + €0,25.
- GoFundMe offers you to personalise your fundraiser according to your needs.
- It does not matter if you reach your fundraising goal or not. You get to keep all the donations you have gathered.
- You can start your fundraiser in other languages like Italian, German and French.
- There is the GoFundMe app makes it simple to launch and manage your fundraiser on the go.

3. Kickstarter

KICKSTARTER

One of the most popular global online platforms for individuals to raise money for their personal causes is the Brooklyn-based crowdfunding platform, [Kickstarter](#). This platform allows people to start a campaign for any type of charitable organisation. Through Kickstarter Slovenia, all pledges are considered to be “all-or-nothing.” Projects that reach their goal will not have to pay fees. This ensures that the creators have a clear understanding of their budget before starting work on their projects.

Features –

- A service fee of 5%, along with 3% + \$0.20 per transaction for payment processing
- Kickstarter supports projects from a variety of categories like art, comics, music, and photography.
- Funding on Kickstarter is all-or-nothing. No one will be charged for a pledge towards a project unless it reaches its funding goal. This way, creators always have the budget they scoped out before moving forward.
- Fundraisers can download their Kickstarter data if they want.
- Fundraisers can also get direct messages from donors for better transparency.

4. GoGetFunding



[GoGetFunding](#) is a peer-to-peer crowdfunding platform that allows people to acquire funds for various purposes, such as organising events and personal expenses. It was first established in 2011 and has since become one of the most popular platforms for [online fundraising](#).

With GoGetfunding, users can raise money to keep their pledges even if they don't reach their goal. It can be very time-intensive and challenging to start a crowdfunding campaign, but with GoGetfunding, one can easily reach out to a wide network of supporters.

Features –

- Offers GoGetFunding Card Payments in a number of countries.
- Free registration.
- GoGetFunding charges a total of a 6.9% fee on funds raised (2.9% of which is a payment processing fee*) and an additional 0.30c handling fee that is applied to each donation made.

5. Crowdcube



Established in 2010, [Crowdcube](#) was the first online platform as European equity crowdfunding platform. Since then, Crowdcube has become one of the most prominent platforms in the global equity [crowdfunding](#) industry. Through it, investors can assess the risks associated with investing in start-ups and make informed decisions.

In 2014, Crowdcube introduced the Crowdcube VC Fund, which provides investors with the assurance that their funds are being managed by a seasoned fund manager. The platform has made it easier for European entrepreneurs to raise capital by giving them a variety of options.

Features –

- Charges a 7% commission if you reach your goal and a 1% completion fee.
- People who invest in a business on Crowdcube become an investor in the company and are eligible to have a share of ownership, or equity, in that business.
